Demolition of Highway 22 Bridge and Impacts to the Wilson Boat Ramp

August 5, 2024, Jackson Wyo. – The Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) will begin demolition of the Wyoming Highway 22 bridge on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, with work continuing for approximately two weeks. Due to its proximity to the bridge, use of the Wilson Boat Ramp may be periodically interrupted throughout the demolition process.

Teton County/Jackson Parks and Recreation staff will coordinate with WYDOT's contractor to communicate with the public when the boat ramp will be impacted. There may be occasions when boat launches are delayed in order to protect the safety of workers, boaters, and public. A contractor representative will be on the ramp during demolition to communicate via radio with the demolition crew to ensure that safety remains the top priority. Those utilizing the ramp during this time should be extra cautious and adhere to staff directions and signs.
