Parks Fall Service Level Update

September 19, 2024, Jackson Wyo. – Over the next several weeks, Teton County/Jackson Parks & Recreation will begin blowing out irrigation systems for the season. To ensure the successful winterization of seasonal restroom infrastructure, restrooms at Town and County parks will be closed beginning Tuesday, October 1, 2024, except for the following: Miller Park and Emily's Pond (open year-round); Stilson (closing on October 15, 2024, and reopening in November); and the Wilson and South Park boat ramps (closing on October 31, 2024).

In addition, there will be increased agronomic practices occurring in Town and County parks over the next month to ensure turf health and successful overwintering. The Owen Bircher riding arena close to the public on Monday, September 30, 2024.

Staff anticipate being able to open the seasonal dog park at the Teton County Fairgrounds during the first week of November. The public is encouraged to visit the Parks and Recreation website and social media accounts for the most up to date information regarding seasonal closures and openings.
